Tour Description

A : Mountains, Lochs & Glens

These three words are the epitome of Scotland – this five day tour has all in abundance. We start out riding north-west and head to Glen Coe the scene of the bloodiest massacre in Scottish history, before taking a detour along one of the most scenic unspoilt glens on offer. Throughout this tour we navigate through the heart of the highlands where we go in search of native wildlife and into Speyside, famous for its single malts. No trip would be complete without a search for that elusive monster on Loch Ness. As each day unfolds more gems are on offer with fantastic roads for motorcycling and in the evenings relax in traditional Scottish surroundings.

B : Isles of Skye & Mull

The Inner Hebridean Isles of Skye and Mull offer truly breath taking scenery, both very different in what they have to offer. Over six days this tour is packed with history and landmarks, including castles and the ancient

Abbey on the Isle of Iona – one of Scotland's most historic and sacred sites dating back to 563 AD. Utilising ferries to facilitate our passage between mainland and the Isles, our route takes in the most westerly part of the British mainland before heading onto Skye where we explore all that the isle has to offer including visits to traditional industries.

C : Around the Coast

This five day tour is more than just a lap of the Scottish coastline – we cover the famous North Coast 500, and more. Riding on some of the most spectacular roads that Scotland has to offer. You will see the stark contrast in landscapes as we navigate around the mainland. We take in Duncansby Head and its coastal stacks before a visit to John O'Groats – the “end of the road”. The views across the Pentland Firth are stunning and one can't help admiring the lovingly restored John O'Groats Hotel now called the Inn at John O'Groats. Continuing our circuit we visit the true northerly point of the mainland, and before descending down the west side we make a stop at a truly unique industry. Followed by a ride through scenery can only be described as magnificent. On this journey we stay in some historical hotels sampling the finest local cuisine.
